

Holiday Camps FAQ's

What are ArtShed holiday camps like?

Each day we will do a different art project and children will learn to complete these projects with step-by-step guidance whilst also having the freedom to be able to make them their own. The camps are very structured and are designed to provide engaging and fun activities with plenty of running around time built in....It is the holidays after all!

Can my child come for just one day?

Yes. However be warned that most children desperately want to come back again and then it can be too late as we are fully booked. Better to be safe than sorry!

My child is NEARLY 6, can they come?

We do take a few 5yr olds if they are nearly 6 so it's worth asking.

Can you take childcare vouchers?

Sorry but we are not able to take childcare vouchers.

Are your staff DBS Checked and 'First Aid' trained.

All our adult staff are DBS checked. There is at least one trained 'First Aider' on any staff team.

How does the day run?

Sample timetable (will vary slightly according to the project requirements):

9.30am - Registration

9:45am - Introduction followed by first Art Session

11:00am - Break time - Children have to drink part of their water bottle before they are allowed two biscuits (supplied by ArtShed)

11:30am - Art Session

12:30pm - Packed lunch picnic (supplied by parents)

1:00pm - Games session (optional)

1:30pm - Art Session

3.00pm - Finishing/Drying Time & Play break

3:30pm - ArtShed closes / pick up time

Do you offer Wrap Around Care?

Wrap around care in our Hertfordshire-based camps runs from 8.30am-5.30 pm and can be booked at extra cost. Children during this time are free to choose what they do with supervision.

Wrap around care in our Cheshire-based camps runs from 7.30am-6.00pm and is provided by Highfields Academy KidSpace and booked separately with them.
